FATHER RYAN STAWAISZ HEROIC SERVICE IN HIS FINAL DAYS

Shortly before his ordination, Ryan Stawaisz received a devastating cancer diagnosis—his second one after successfully beating cancer as a junior in college.

Despite his diagnosis, Fr. Ryan began his priestly ministry at Prince of Peace in Houston in 2019. Just two years later, on June 21, 2021, the young priest passed away, leaving a lasting impact on his parishioners, many of whom attested to his tremendous witness.

Those who knew Fr. Ryan were deeply touched by his selfless ministry, even in his final days as a priest—so much so that he has inspired a film about his life.

His brother Ross Stawaisz says he hopes Fr. Ryan’s story will show the “need to stand up for some things. You need to live your life in a way that emulates Christ.”

Fr. Ryan’s mother, Susan Stawaisz, said she has heard from several cancer patients on how the movie has touched them: “I feel like anybody who’s gone through any kind of suffering can relate to offering up your suffering and suffering heroically.”

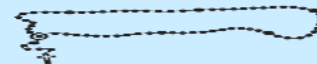
