



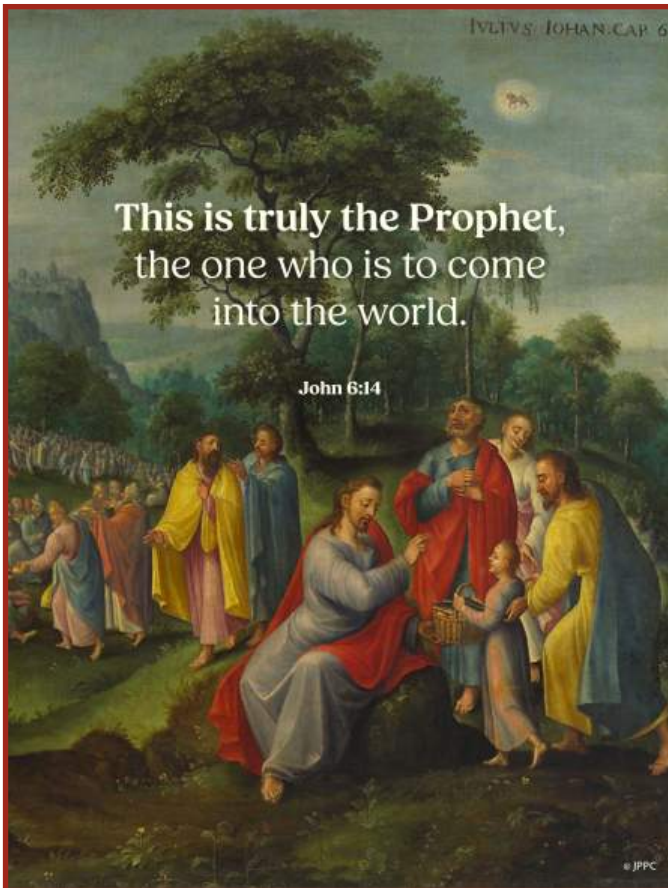

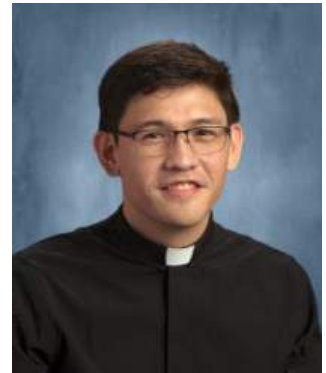
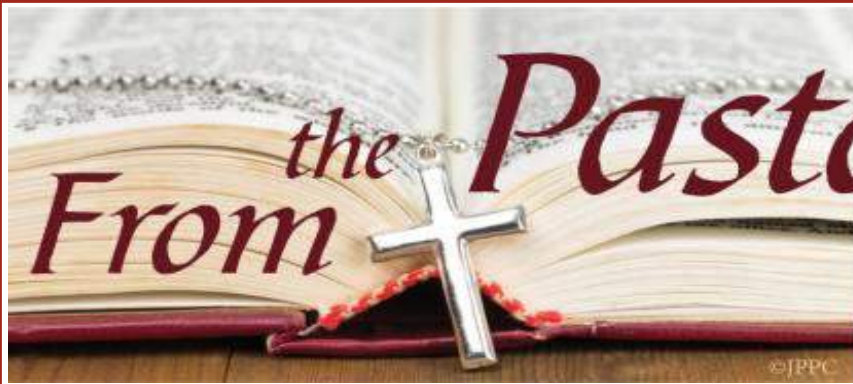

Dear Parishioners,

In the Gospel this week, Jesus multiplies five barley loaves and two fish (sounds healthy!) to feed a multitude. Its a reminder to all of us: give everything you can to God, even if it seems impossibly small for the task at hand. Our 100% is tiny compared to his 100%, but he wants our full participation none the less!

And this warms my heart - Jesus doesn't want anything wasted. He has the fragments gathered for later use. He provides over-abundantly, and yet not wastefully. Surely something to think about for our own lives!

I'm using both of these principles in managing the parish. My 100% has not been enough to run this place with anything approaching competency as of yet. With 1,500 families in our parish and just one inexperienced priest, there are going to be some unanswered calls and emails. Not long ago, it took 30 years to be named a pastor. Now it takes five. With some overly-simple math, there are 1/6 the number of competent priests available today than even 40 years ago in Philadelphia. Certainly our expectations of our priests haven't shrunk to 1/6th of what they once were!

So I ask for your patience and understanding as I learn the ropes of being a pastor. I'm very conscious that this isn't a sprint - it is a marathon. I want to be saying Mass at 102 years old. I'd do much more good for the Church that way than by running myself into addictions and off the job. Lord knows the Church has had too much of that!

On that other principal of curbing wastefulness, I'm putting some attention into our financials and sustainability. For example, I'd like our A/C thermostats to be upgraded to be "smart" so they aren't running as much when no one is there to benefit. The rectory cable subscription has also been cut in favor of internet TV.

Another big one for me is thoughtful use of space. I really do hate clutter, and we seem to have an abundance of it! If anyone has input about what is in storage and what we can get rid of, do let me or the parish office staff know.

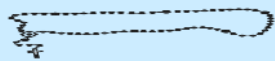
