REGISTRATION FOR NEW PARISHIONERS:

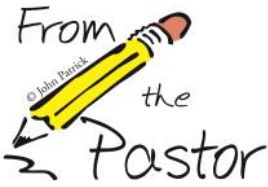

Presentation of the Offertory Gifts of Bread & Wine:

If you are having a particular Mass offered for a loved one and would like to bring up the gifts, please see the Ushers before Mass. If you and/or your family/friends would like to bring up the gifts, also, please see an Usher before Mass.

Reserved Seats in the Front of Church:

If you need Holy Communion during Mass, but are not able to walk to the Altar, please sit in the special reserved pews in the front of Church. The front pews are reserved for you and will help with the distribution of Holy Communion. Presently, Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion and Ushers are walking throughout the congregation and sometimes are unaware of who gets Holy Communion or who was missed. A reserved sitting area for you in the front pews would prevent this from happening at 5 different Masses. Priests and EM's would come to you first with Holy Communion after they leave the sanctuary.



Eucharistic Adoration

Eucharistic Adoration is open to all and is held every Tuesday from 8 am to 6:45 pm and concludes with a 7 pm Mass. You may come at anytime and stay for any length of time.

We are in need of adorers for 8 am and 12 Noon.

In August, we would like to extend the Adoration hours on Tuesday evening. Immediately, following the 7 pm mass, the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed until 9 pm. 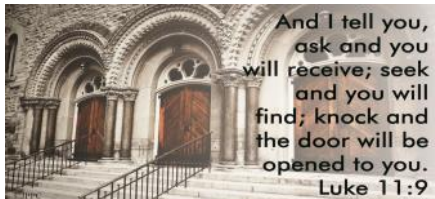

PREP Registration for the 2018-2019 year continues through July 23rd. Paperwork received on July 24th or after will incur a surcharge. The first day of classes will be Sunday, September 9th and Tuesday, September 11th.

What is needed to register your family:

- 1) a PREP Family Faith Formation **REGISTRATION** form
- 2) a Student Information form for **NEW** students
- 3) A copy of your child's **BAPTISMAL CERTIFICATE**, if baptized outside Sacred Heart; if baptized at Sacred Heart, please note the exact Baptism date on the information form
- 4) Transfer information from another Program or Catholic School (if applicable)
- 5) Payment

Registration packets are available at the desk in the narthex, from our parish office during business hours or via our website at www.sacredheat.us under the **FAITH FORMATION** tab.
